

## Code of Conduct

I, \_\_\_\_\_\_, promise to abide by the rules and safety regulations in place for our Clemmons:One Connect Ministry. I understand that should I not abide by the following rules, I will be asked to not return for the following week(s) and/or will have parents called regarding my behavior.

I promise to abide by the following rules and safety regulations:

- Before arrival I will ensure that my computer/iPad is fully charged and pack my charging cord along with all other school supplies and books I may need
- Upon arrival I will immediately go to the check-in table to have my temperature checked, to sign-up for my Connect Team for the day, and to retrieve my locker key and locker number.
- I will keep my key attached to its key chain and keep that on my person at all times throughout the day in order to turn it back in when I check-out.
- When under our Connect Tent completing schoolwork, I will:
  - Wear headphones
  - Stay muted on my computer/iPad unless specifically answering a question or participating in discussion with my class
  - I will keep my voice low and refrain from actions that may be distracting to my peers also completing their schoolwork
- When on a break from school, I will:
  - Stop at our coordination table and inform our Tent Coordinator what time my break ends. (While you are all responsible youth, this will serve as a back-up in case you are distracted with friends or engaged in another activity).
  - Wear a mask at all times that I am within 6" of another person.
  - Treat all equipment and supplies with utmost care and respect. We want our supplies to last!
- When using the restroom, I will:
  - Take a buddy with me and/or inform Amanda or Tent Coordinator where I am going.
  - Leave the bathroom as nicely as I found it, if not better.
  - Make sure the water faucet is fully turned off.
  - o Tell Amanda about any restroom problems such as non-functioning toilets or messes.
  - Wear a mask at all times inside the church building
  - Refrain from venturing inside the church. You are only permitted in the restrooms. All other places within the church are off-limits at this time with Kindergarten and Pre-K also in session.
  - Restrooms are also closed during drop-off and pick-up for Pre-K and Kindergarten. Times restrooms are closed will be posted.
- At the close of the day, I will pack up all of my belongings, clean up and throw away any mess I have created, clean out my locker, and take my key to the check-out table.
